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Dear Parents and Carers

Learning at Home

In the light of the national response to the coronavirus crisis, we now expect schools to be closed for the foreseeable future so recommend that your children engage in learning activities as part of a 'usual routine'. Whilst this will not be the same as your children being in school, it will give structure to their day and allow them to keep recent learning fresh and stimulate interest in new learning.

Building a daily schedule for learning activity at home will help to make sure you regularly visit key areas of learning eg. maths, reading, writing, spelling but also ensure that children are getting time for exercise and creative activities involving art, music etc. Scheduling time outside and away from screens is also advisable.
