Wrap – Around Care at North Leigh CE Primary School

At North Leigh CE Primary School, we are very aware that securing reliable, convenient and reasonably priced childcare both before and after school can pose problems for working parents and carers.

For this reason, we consider ourselves very fortunate in being able to offer both Breakfast and After School Club provision, on site, to our families from Monday to Friday.

Breakfast Club

The Breakfast Club is run by the North Leigh Pre-School and is held in their building (on the playground) and in the school hall. It operates from 7.45am to 8.40am and costs £7.50 including breakfast. If you are interested in booking a place at Breakfast Club, please complete the form enclosed in this starter pack and return to school who will pass this on to North Leigh Pre School who deal with registration and bookings.

Windmill After School Club

The Windmill After School Club, managed directly by the school and based in the school hall, offers child care provision for children aged from 4 to 11 years from 3.10pm to 5.30pm Monday to Friday in term time. The Club provides a range of supervised indoor and outdoor activities for children, varied across the week, and a healthy snack and drink at 4.00pm (fruit will be available immediately after school for those children who want it).

Pricing is based on full or half sessions as follows:

Full Session 3.10pm – 5.30pm £12.75

Half session 3.10pm – 4.15pm £ 8.00

Half Session (for children joining after extra-curricular or sports clubs) 4.15pm – 5.30pm £8.00

Ad-Hoc Booking Fee: £1.00 per child

Late Fee: £6.50 per 15 minutes per child
