
# MEET THE TEACHER



## PE AND OUTDOOR LEARNING



- ► Homework will focus on key skills for learning reading and times tables.
- Children are expected to read every night with an age appropriate book.
- We would like to focus on core skills in home learning.
- Being confident in reading is the gateway to the curriculum; as such, we would like children to read every night and record in their reading record.
- Reading records will be collected fortnightly and reads counted. Children who have read 10 times or more will be entered in the book draw, where they can win a book from our book vending machine!

## HOMEWORK



#### **Reading expectations in Year 5**

Children are expected to read at home every night and record in their reading record.

Children need to have an age appropriate reading book. Children will be supported by their class teacher choosing a book which challenges and interests them. Parents can support their child in selecting a book using the 5 finger rule.

Reading records will be handed in every other week on a Wednesday




